

Consumers Energy Company, pursuant to 18 C.F. R. § 358.7(a)(2), provides notice that it inadvertently disclosed non-public Transmission Function Information to one of its Marketing Function Employees on May 11, 2018. The non-public Transmission Function Information was real time transmission tie line names and flow information for the Consumers Energy & METC service territory. The Marketing Function Employee, immediately upon seeing the non-public Transmission Function Information, closed the data window and reported the disclosure in accordance with Consumers Energy's FERC Standards of Conduct procedure. Because the non-public Transmission Function information is considered confidential Critical Energy Infrastructure Information, as defined in 18 C.F. R. § 388.113(c)(2), Consumers Energy under 18 C.F.R. §358.7(a)(2) provides this Notice of Disclosure that non-public Transmission Function Information was disclosed.
