Please consider this letter a formal request of <u>Company/Corporation</u> to voluntarily "opt-out" of the Energy Efficiency Program offered by Consumers Energy and thereby run our own energy efficiency program. This request applies to the following Consumers Energy Gas Transportation accounts with annual natural gas usage greater than 100,000 MCF per year at each account.

By "opting-out" these accounts are no longer eligible to participate in the Energy Efficiency Program offered by Consumers Energy or receive rebates for energy savings projects which may be installed. Accounts that received or plan to receive an energy efficiency incentive from Consumers Energy in the current year must wait until January 1 of the next year to "opt-out". I would like the "opt-out" program to begin <u>ASAP or later date</u>.

I understand that my company is required to run its own energy efficiency program and will receive a lower energy efficiency (EE) surcharge. I also understand my company is required to submit an annual energy savings report due to Consumers Energy by March 1 each year, reporting the prior year's implemented energy savings attributable to my "opt-out" accounts in a format provided by Consumers Energy. Reported savings should meet or exceed the minimum annual savings. Minimum annual energy savings are equal to 0.75% of my "opt-out" accounts prior year's annual usage. Failure to meet the minimum annual energy savings will result in notification to the Michigan Public Service Commission and may require the account to

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involuntarily "opt-in". In addition, my gas usage must remain > 100,000 MCF annually (as determined in January based on the prior year's usage) to maintain my "opt-out" status.

I understand there is a one-time voluntarily return or "opt-in" option. Customers that "opt-in" are required to pay the full EE surcharge retroactive to January 1 of the year in which they "opt-in". "Opt-out" customers choosing to "opt-in" are no longer eligible to opt-out or until such time that regulatory action might occur that could change circumstances.
