The Challenge: Spanning four locations over a storied 63-year history, Herbruck's Poultry Ranch is the largest producer of eggs in Michigan and the 9th largest in the United States. From keeping the birds comfortable in climate-controlled environments to refrigeration of the finished product, producing eggs requires an enormous amount of energy. After taking over the energy program in 2017, Senior Manager of Operations Cody Herbruck began looking for opportunities to achieve its sustainability goals while reducing the cost burden of energy usage.

The Solution: Consumers Energy spent a day at Herbruck's Poultry Ranch performing a walk-through at every facility to identify energy efficiency projects. Within days, Herbruck's Poultry Ranch discovered it was eligible for more rebates than they previously thought! The savings freed up more capital to reinvest in energy efficiency programs and innovations, such as a timed heating and lighting schedule that mimics the best egg-laying conditions.

The Result: After the walk-through, Herbruck's Poultry Ranch introduced a multitude of new projects, such as LED lighting, network lighting controls, integrated HVAC controls and 15 energy efficiency projects. Not only did these projects save a total of 745,500 kWh, but they also maximized and promoted bird comfort and promote the innovative spirit for which Herbruck's Poultry Ranch is known.
