The Renewable Energy Program is certified by Green-e® Energy. As part of this certification, we are required to provide you with detailed information about the product, including this Product Content Label and the program's Price, Terms and Conditions.

When you enroll in the Renewable Energy Program, you match up to 100% of your monthly kilowatt-hour (kWh) energy usage with renewable energy. The product is comprised of the following new renewable resources averaged annually.

## Price, Terms, and Conditions

Company	Consumers Energy
How much does it cost?	Participants can select how much renewable energy they would like to subscribe to. They will be charged at an agreed upon fixed subscription fee per kilowatt hour. Check out the enrollment calculator on the Renewable Energy Program website to see the subscription cost and the impact your enrollment can make.
Will my subscription costs change over time?	Your subscription fee will remain fixed for the duration that you are enrolled in the program. However, the bill credit you receive will vary monthly due to changes in the market value of renewable energy.
What happens if I move?	If you move within Consumers Energy's electric service territory, your enrollment in the program will move with you. If you move out of Consumers Energy's electric service territory, your subscription will be canceled and there is no penalty.
Can I cancel participation in the program?	Yes, the program is optional and after the initial 12-month commitment residential customers can cancel with no penalty.  For contracted C&I customers an early termination fee may apply.
