PROGRESS UPDATE #17 FLINT EAST BOULEVARD FORMER MGP SITE



Work completed between 12/23/2017 and 2/16/2018 includes the following:

- No work was performed over the holiday break (December 23 to January 7) aside from periodic checks on the site and demobilization of equipment.
- Continued decontaminating and demobilizing equipment.
- Deconstructed and demobilized the wastewater treatment system.
- Removed material used to construct the dewatering and material handling pad.
- Decommissioned remaining infrastructure related to structural monitoring.
- Placed and graded topsoil to restore riverbanks and upland areas of the site (see Photos 1 and 2).
- Continued restoring riverbanks and upland areas (see Photo 3).
- Installed monitoring wells to replace monitoring wells that were damaged during construction (see Photo 4).
- Installed additional erosion controls throughout the Work Area.
- Placed additional gravel and performed additional grading of the temporary bike path.
- Removed the temporary access road constructed in the southwest corner of Parking Lot A.
- Replaced signage along East Boulevard drive.
- Swept and cleaned roads and sidewalks throughout the Work Area.

Upcoming work includes the following:

- Work planned from February 19th to April will likely include:
 - o Removal of the temporary fence around Consumers parking lot after new gates are installed at all four entrances.
 - o Installation of new light poles along East Boulevard.
 - o Routine inspections of soil erosion and sedimentation control devices. Local staff and equipment will be available to address issues identified during routine inspections.
- Work planned for April (weather dependent) includes the following:
 - o Final restoration and seeding of riverbanks and upland areas.
 - o Paving the bike path with asphalt.
 - o Replacement of concrete sidewalks and curbs damaged during construction.
 - o Restoration of brick patios, benches, and bike racks along the riverbanks.
- The next project update will be sent after restoration work in the spring begins.
