Gas Meter Backerboard Requirements



Consumers Energy requires gas meters to be mounted to a weatherproof, permanent backerboard on houses that will receive siding (see Figure 1). This document outlines the specifications and materials required for the backerboard.



CAUTION

Consumers Energy reserves the right to refuse to connect a service to an improperly installed backerboard or meter stand (pedestal).

Backerboard Requirements

- The backerboard's material must meet the requirements set forth in <u>Michigan Building Code</u>, <u>Chapter 14 Exterior Walls</u>. It is also permissible to purchase a pre-made meter mounting base from a construction supplier or a home improvement retailer. The goal is to establish a secure, flat mounting surface.
- The board's color is the owner's preference.

Meter Relocation

If you are remodeling your home's exterior, including updating your siding, you may need to relocate your meter. During the process of meter relocation, you will need to add a backerboard on the home at the meter's new location.
