#### Legislative Report

Watch for the "No Turn on Red" Signs: A permissible "Right Turn on Red" was introduced in the 1970s as a fuel savings measure but due to the increase in pedestrian injuries at traffic intersections, cities are increasing the number of intersections where there is "No Turn on Red". For example, Washington D. C. will end most right-on-red turns by 2025, the state of Hawaii has prohibited right-on-red turns in part of Honolulu and in Michigan, Ann Arbor has recently banned right-on-red turns at 50 downtown intersections. Watch for the "No Turn on Red" traffic signs. **Michigan License Plates**: Three vintage license plate designs from the 1970s and 1980s may soon be available. The legislature has overwhelmingly passed a bill to reintroduce three license plate designs from the 1970s and 1980s as specialty plates. The bill is waiting for the governor's approval.
