**Game:** Starts at 11:15am. We need to arrive between 9:45 & 10:00am.

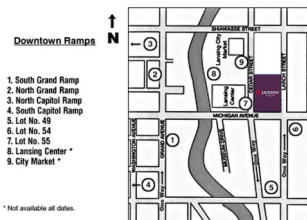
**Tickets:** One of our board members will be at the Entrance to hand out tickets.

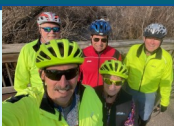
