Game: Starts at 11:15am. We need to **arrive between 9:45 & 10:00am.**

Cost: \$45.00 a Person **We will take the first 60 registrations with payment.**

The Clubhouse only holds 60 people.

Food: All-You-Can-Eat Brunch Buffet will be served before and during the game.

Pick up Tickets on Game Day: "Will Call" Box Office Window will have an envelope with your name and tickets.

Purse Rule: Remember your purse should be small and clear if possible. (see back)

Location: Jackson Field 505 E. Michigan Ave in Lansing

Directions: US- 127 North towards Lansing. Take I-496 West to downtown Lansing. Take exit 7 and turn right on Cedar Street. The stadium is approximately one mile on the left.

Parking: Handicap parking it is right in front of the stadium. (see map on pg. 2)

Clubhouse Suite: Located along the third base line to the left of the Stadium Entrance. Enter the main walkway, then turn left when we reach the main isle. Walk a short distance, the doors or take the elevators for "the Club House" is on the left. An email will be sent a week before the game with information on the event.

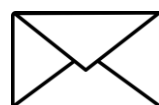

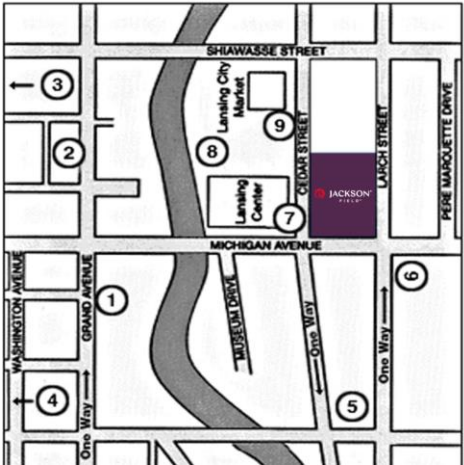
