2023 Forerunners Scholarship Information

FORERUNNERS, an association of retirees from CMS-affiliated companies, has established a scholarship award program for current year graduating high school seniors. The award can be used for tuition, books, or educational expenses. Scholarship recipients are randomly selected for one of the awards below.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Children, stepchildren and legal dependents
- Grandchildren and step-grandchildren of Forerunners members
- Applicant needs to be a graduating high school senior with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above and plan to follow a full-time first-year student program at a college, university, post-secondary, or trade school
- Only one scholarship per year can be awarded to a Forerunner member
