There were giant icicles hanging from the tower and frozen water over the whole parking lot. The icicles were dangerous and a threat to the safety of workers. A crane was brought in to break off the frozen daggers of ice.

Others of talked about the blizzard of 1978, which is sometimes called the White Hurricane. It struck on January 25<sup>th</sup> that year. It is reported to have been the 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest recorded air pressure on the mainland US in history. Snowfalls ranged in the Midwest from 12" to 36" with 12-20 foot snow drifts. Tony Homolka recalled going to work that day on a snowmobile. The only way he knew he was on the highway was to watch the electric poles and try to stay between them. He picked up Dale Mehki on the road where he had gotten stuck. After tipping over several times, they both made it to the J.R. Whiting plant. They didn't get home for a couple of days since workers couldn't get in. Joe Simek took all the soup cans from the vending machine and cooked them together in a pot along with any food they could find. The Erie fire department eventually came and brought food on their snowmobiles. The plant kept the power going even though the coal came in frozen with snow and mud. The operators had to beat the pipes with sledgehammers to keep the coal going to the mills.
