Medicare counseling is provided on the 3rd Wednesday of each month. Call for an appointment at 734-856-3330 to get answers to this sometimes confusing process.

Dianne is also very busy planning travel trips for senior. Many classes, activities and special events are planned through the year, such as exercise and craft classes. Dianne encouraged

us to get familiar with agencies that support seniors. The Bedford Health van supplies nonemergency health transportation to doctor's offices for a \$35.00 round trip charge.
